WHAT WILL WE SAY?

On the weekend of March 23rd I was stirred in my spirit to go to the book of Revelation where the following message was imparted to me. It began with verse 4:

“ - - Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, - - .”

I was then directed to Isaiah 11:2 where the seven Spirits who are before the throne of GOD are identified. The seventh Spirit is “the fear of the Lord.” It is this Spirit that has withdrawn from the church as we know it. Where the fear of the Lord is absent, there is an absence of reverence and respect. This leaves a great void that is filled with much fleshly activity, lots of noise and many, many words. I was shown that in a fearless environment “silence” is almost nonexistent. It is in silence that FATHER speaks the loudest to man.

What John saw and heard, you and I will also see, concerning the throne of GOD and –

One like the Son of Man, who is clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band. His head and hair are white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes are like a flame of fire; His feet are like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters;

He holds in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth goes a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance is like the sun shining in its strength.

When John saw Him as He is today he fell down as if dead! The Spirit of the fear of GOD had overwhelmed him. Today, we think nothing of entering into His presence with our minds and mouths filled with the flesh of the world, all the while “proudly” proclaiming who we are in JESUS. MAY GOD HAVE MERCY!

The words that John heard, you and I will hear. Listen and imagine what it will be like as you hear the following:

“I am He who holds the seven stars in My right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lamp stands:”

“I KNOW YOUR WORKS!”

“I am the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life;”

“I KNOW YOUR WORKS!”

“I am He who has the sharp two-edged sword:”

“I KNOW YOUR WORKS!”

I am the Son of GOD, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and My feet are like fine brass:"

"I KNOW YOUR WORKS!"

I am He who has the seven Spirits of GOD and the seven stars:"

"I KNOW YOUR WORKS!"

I am He who is holy, He who is true, He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts and shuts and no one opens:"

"I KNOW YOUR WORKS!"

"I am the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, The Beginning of the creation of GOD:"

"I KNOW YOUR WORKS!"

As you and I come before pure Holiness, to answer to Him who sees our beginning, our end and the whole of our being - - -

Will our behavior before Him be the same as it is today? Will our mouths continue to proclaim who we are in Him? Will we clap our hands and skip and dance around Him who sits on the throne and is like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance, where there is a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald?

Will we break out laughing?

You and I will see first hand the twenty four thrones for the elders that surround "the throne". You and I will see continual shards of lightning, we will hear the rolling thunder and the voices coming from the throne. How will we respond to this sight? Will our fearless, overly familiar, presumptuous and flippant attitude toward GOD still be with us?

As the four living creatures, the sight of which would strike fear in the hardest of hearts, are heard crying out:

"Holy, holy, holy,
Lord God Almighty
Who was and is and is to come!"

Will we do our Baptist thing, our Methodist thing, our charismatic thing, etc. etc? What will we do as we watch the 24 elders "fall down" before Him and worship Him who lives forever and ever? What will we have to say for ourselves? If we leave here and arrive there with no fear of GOD, how will we respond to what we see and hear?

I was shown that as we draw closer to Him, our voice will begin to subside and our words will become fewer and fewer, until we come before Him and then WE WILL BE SILENT, except for a cry flowing from our spirit – "My GOD have mercy on me!"

Now is the time, this is the hour to prepare to meet our GOD face to face! For the most part, the church as we know it, is not ready to meet her GOD. This includes your church and my church. Today much of our effort is directed toward organized church growth and the preservation of what we view as the church system. The end result of our efforts is that we have produced a people who do not fear GOD and who reflect the world and its ways! If you believe otherwise you are either deceived or intellectually dishonest.

Sadly, teaching the people to separate themselves from the world, to pursue holiness and the fear of the Lord is not popular today. It is considered to be too negative and not in keeping with the “feel good” flow of being in the River of GOD. But what does FATHER have to say on the subject?

“---Gather the people to ME, and I will let them hear MY words, that they may learn to fear ME all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.” (Deuteronomy 4:10)

“The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever:” (Psalm 19:9)

“Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.” (Psalm 33:8)

Of the wicked it is said: “There is no fear of GOD before his eyes.” (Psalm 36:1) and of GOD’S people it is said: “They shall fear YOU as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations.” (Psalm 72:5) How would the Psalmist view us?

FATHER further declares in Psalms 111:10 that the fear of Him is the beginning of wisdom. One reason that there is so little true wisdom and spiritual discernment in the church today is that there is virtually no fear of GOD beyond the lips of man! Solomon, who was blessed with the wisdom of GOD, after he had tried the world and its ways, said this:

“Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear GOD and keep His commandments, for this is man’s all.” (Ecclesiastes 12:13)

Finally, JESUS, Himself, commanded us to fear GOD! (See Matthew 10:28)

We can say anything and claim anything. We can declare who we are in JESUS and quote all the right scripture. We can point proudly to our good works, our fine church buildings and all of our programs designed to reach the lost. But I must tell you the truth! We have nothing to boast about before GOD! Without the Spirit of the fear of the Lord, we are just a religious people!

May our GOD open our eyes and our ears to His truth. May He show us our true spiritual condition in relation to His Holiness. May He set His people free from all religious bondage. May He reveal JESUS as He is to His people and may the “Spirit of the fear of the Lord” return to the hearts of the people and may that fear and reverence that He deserves return to the sanctuary of the saints!
